International Service

Serving Abroad

Throughout the year, we traveled on four international service trips. We were able to serve 1,154 patients with the help of 49 volunteers. We donated over \$614,000 in dentistry, changing the lives of patients across Ethiopia, Fiji, and Guatemala. Patients' lives were not the only thing changed but the heart for service in our volunteers grew two-fold. During September, our clinic was also host to over 20 dental students and faculty from The University of the Pacific who saw over 220 patients over one week. However, the dentistry didn't end there as we hosted three dental students from the University of San Carlos, who completed an eight month residency serving patients in our clinic.
